Information on Waste Collection, Recycling, & Drop Off

<u>Household Solid Waste</u> - Collected Monday through Friday on the designated day for your area. If you are not sure when your designated day for pick up is, you may view the Waste Collection Schedule or call Town Hall at 965-9841.

<u>Household Solid Waste</u> generated by the normal day to day operation or occupancy of a residence will be collected once a week, Monday thru Thursday, on the designated day for your area from the **curbside**. You may view the Waste Collection Schedule for your street by clicking on the link or call Town Hall at 965-9841 for information. Solid Waste must be placed in the 90-gallon roll-out container provided by the Town. Any additional containers must be approved by the Public Works Director. Containers must be placed at the street the night before the day of collection.

<u>Yard Waste</u> is collected on Monday for residents living on the south side of Anderson Street and on Tuesday for residents on the north side of Anderson Street.

- □ Tree limbs & shrubbery
 - Must be stacked in separate pile from other rubbish.
 - Limbs should be stacked neatly and placed butt end to the adjacent curb or street.
 - Limbs must not exceed six (6) feet in length and six (6) inches in diameter.
- □ Leaves, pine straw, pine combs, and grass clippings
 - Must be bagged or boxed

Recyclables

The Town will begin mandatory recycling on July 2nd and 3rd. If your solid waste pickup is on Monday or Wednesday, your recycling will be picked up on Thursday. If your solid waste pickup is on Tuesday or Thursday your recycling will be picked up on Friday.

Materials should be placed in the 65-gallon bin and placed on the curbside the night before the day of collection. Acceptable items to recycle are:

- Newspapers Including inserts
- Cardboard
- Glass containers Food or beverage, brown, green, or clear
- Cans aluminum & bi-metal
- Plastic containers soft drink bottles, milk jugs, etc.

Below is a list of items with specific instructions for discarding. The Town of Selma Public Works Department is located at <u>311 S. Webb Street</u>, and items requiring drop off there, can be taken <u>Monday through Friday between 7:30 am and 3:30 pm</u>. Drop off for these items is also available at the Johnston County Landfill located in Smithfield.

<u>Paint/Paint Cans</u>: Fill the cans (empty or not) with sand. Place the sand-filled cans beside of your roll out trash container for pickup on garbage collection day.

Motor Oil: Town of Selma Public Works department has a container for disposing motor oil.

<u>Furniture</u>: Place household furniture, including TV sets, beside of your roll out trash container for pickup on garbage collection day.

<u>Tires</u>: Tires may be dropped off at the Town of Selma Public Works department. *<u>Tires must be OFF the rims before dropping off.</u>

<u>Appliances</u>: Household appliances (washers, dryers, refrigerators, etc.) may be dropped off at the Town of Selma Public Works department.

<u>Cars</u>: The following organizations provide pickup and towing services, usually free of charge. Both organizations will discuss with you how you can donate your vehicle(s) for their pickup program.

<u>Construction or Demolition Materials/Debris</u>: Small amounts of construction debris will be collected by the Public Works Department as time allows. Excessive amounts of construction materials as a result of remodeling will be the owner's responsibility to remove. In the event excessive amounts of material are placed at the curb and collected by the Town, the property owner will be charged hauling and landfill fees. Excessiveness will be determined by a town representative.

Mattresses/Bedding: Same as "Furniture".

<u>Automobile Parts (motors, fenders, etc.)</u>: Disposal of automobile parts, etc. will be the owner's responsibility, and should be taken to the Johnston County Landfill in Smithfield.
